The association will include men and women who have received the Pontifical Equestrian Order of Pope Pius IX, the Pontifical Equestrian Order of Saint Gregory the Great, the Pontifical Equestrian Order of Pope Saint Sylvester, the Cross *Pro Ecclesia et Pontifice* and the Cross *Benemerenti*.

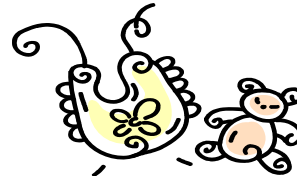
